



#### **VOCATION CORNER**

"You also must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect."

Luke 12:40

Today's Gospel reminds us that we never know when God's call may come. Would we be ready and open if God were to invite us to serve him in a special way today? To reach out to someone in need or start a new journey of faith? This is especially true of a call to vocation.
