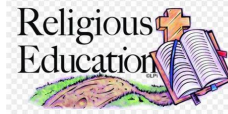
SEMINARIAN BURSE DONATIONS

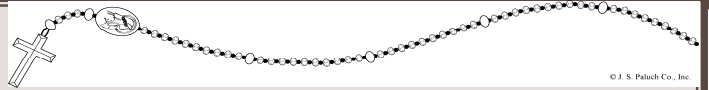
